- Grooved telescoping stainless steel shaft; design prevents rotational slipping to ensure secure positioning and pick-up
- Flexible-obedient gooseneck for access into hard-to-reach areas

Below are details about all 13 tools in the line.

### **Telescoping Lighted Magnetic Pocket Pick-ups (91581, 91582)**

- 91581: Telescopes to 14 in.; features a bright white LED, a magnet that easily lifts 3 lbs. and a pocket clip
- 91582: Telescopes to 22 in.; features 3 bright white LEDs, a magnet that easily lifts 4 lbs. and a pocket clip

### **Heavy-Duty Telescoping Magnetic Pick-up (91383)**

Telescopes to  $21^{5}/8$  in.; features a magnet that easily lifts 5 lbs. and a pocket clip

### **Telescoping Lighted Magnetic Pick-ups with Mirrors (91555, 91557, 91560)**

Each model telescopes to 22 in.; features 3 bright white LEDs, a magnet that easily lifts 4 lbs., a clear polished glass mirror attachment in a strong, protective ABS holder and a pocket clip

- 91555: comes with a 1.5 in. diameter round mirror attachment
- 91557: comes with a 2.2 in. diameter round mirror attachment
- 91560: comes with a 2 in. x 2.8 in. rectangular mirror attachment

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### **Telescoping Inspection Mirrors (90557, 90560, 92557, 92560)**

Each model features a clear polished glass mirror in a strong, protective ABS holder and a pocket clip

- 90557: Telescopes to 23 in.; features a 2.5 in. diameter round mirror
- 90560: Telescopes to 24 in.; features a 2 in. x 3 in. rectangular mirror
- 92557: Telescopes to 23 in.; features a 2.5 in. diameter round mirror with 2 bright white LEDs
- 92560: Telescopes to 24 in.; features a 2 in. x 3 in. rectangular mirror with 2 bright white LEDs

Each model features a heavy-duty aluminum trigger handle, a bright white LED, a 4-prong steel retrieval claw and a flexible silver steel shaft


